As we kick off another exciting year of St. Anthony athletics, we want to take a moment to look back at the incredible accomplishments of our student-athletes over the past year—and share our vision for the upcoming season.

Whether our students are competing on the field, the court or the track, the **St. Anthony Booster Club** is dedicated to supporting every sport, every athlete, and every team.

For the 2026-2027 school year, we want to build on last year's momentum and elevate the experience for every single student-athlete. This year, our core fundraising and support goals are:

- **Re-pavement of the track:** We are aiming to fund the complete re-pavement of the all-weather track.
- **Softball Fencing:** The current fencing is in major need of an upgrade. We would like to replace it this year.
- **Scheduled Maintenance:** Since we have been able to upgrade our transportation fleet, we will continue to keep them maintained so that they can be used for years to come.
- **Continuing Scholarships:** With donations we will continue to fund our student athlete scholarships.

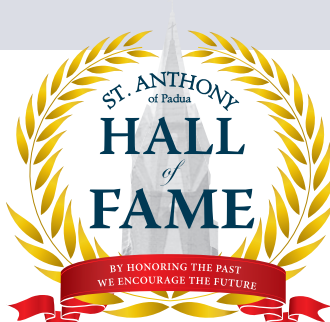

Achievements

2025 - 2026 Post Season Highlights

High School

Girls Golf - Finished 2nd at Regionals and Sectionals and placed 7th at the IHSA State Finals.

Boys Golf - 2A Regional and Sectional Champions and finished 7th at the IHSA State Finals.

Girls Volleyball - Won the National Trail Conference and NTC Tournament, finishing a perfect 9-0 in conference play and 28-6 overall.

Belletes - Placed 4th at IHSA Sectionals and 18th at the IHSA State Finals. Finished 1st at every IDTA competition and won the 1A Jazz State Championship.





Girls Tennis - Placed 3rd at Sectionals and finished 12th as a team at the IHSA State Finals.



Boys Tennis - Finished 7-6 and placed 4th at Mattoon and Sacred Heart-Griffin, along with a 3rd-place finish at the Robinson Doubles Tournament.



Boys Track - Sent three runners to State in the 3200m, 110m hurdles, and 300m hurdles. Eli Hiatt placed 10th in the 110m hurdles and 4th in the 300m hurdles, setting a new school record of 39.31.



Girls Track - Won the NTC Meet and the first State Championship in school history. Aubrey Denning placed 3rd in the 800m, while Reese Hoene won the 200m and 400m, placed 2nd in long jump, and broke four records.

High School (continued)

Softball - Finished the season with a 16-13 record.

Baseball - Finished 2nd in the NTC Tournament in the fall with an undefeated 8-0 conference record. In the spring, the Bulldogs won the Regional Championship and finished 22-10 overall.

Boys Basketball - Won the NTC Tournament and National Trail Conference Championship, finishing 8-1 in conference play and 20-10 overall.

Girls Basketball - Finished the season 19-11. Nancy Ruholl became the all-time leading scorer in St. Anthony basketball history, boys or girls, with 2,473 career points.





Girls Cross Country - NTC Champions, placed 3rd at Regionals and 6th at Sectionals, and finished 13th at the IHSA State Finals.



Boys Cross Country - Won the Saber Corn Classic, NTC Meet, and Regional Championship. Finished 5th at Sectionals and 20th at the IHSA State Finals.



Cheerleading - Won the NTC Cheer Competition for the second consecutive year with zero deductions.



Soccer - Finished the season with a 2-11-3 record, earning wins over ALAH and Vandalia and ties against ALAH, Vandalia, and Pana.



Bass Fishing - Colin Maag and Axton Lankford placed 12th at Regionals, while Keegan and Addie Overbeck finished 2nd and advanced to State, where they placed 17th out of more than 60 boats.

Grade School

Jr High Cross Country - Both the girls and boys teams placed 1st or 2nd in every invitational, including wins at Robinson, Okaw Valley, and Teutopolis. Max Schuette and Sylvia Semple set home course records, while **both teams finished 4th at State.** Sylvia Semple and Bella Schultz also placed in the Top 25 individually.

Jr High Softball - The Jr. High team finished 2-15, but showed strong progress and resilience throughout the season. With several younger players gaining valuable experience, the Bullpups will look to build on that growth in 2026-27.

Jr High Volleyball - The 8th grade team finished an outstanding 23-3 and advanced to the Regional Championship. The 7th grade team showed strong growth throughout the season, gaining valuable experience and building momentum for next year.

Jr High Girls Basketball - Our 7th grade team finished their season in Regional play. Throughout the season the girls improved both individually and as a team. They will be ready to begin their next season with all the experience they gained during the 25-26 school year. Our 8th grade team won the Regional Championship and finished their season in Sectional play.





Jr High Boys Basketball - The 7th grade team capped off a one-loss season by **winning the IESA 2A State Championship**, with Colin Storm earning the Outstanding Sportsmanship Medal. The 8th grade team also put together a strong season with several hard-fought wins.



Jr High Track & Field - Both the boys and girls teams advanced to the IESA State Meet. **The girls 4x400 relay won the State Championship**, while **Nash Hoene also took 1st in the boys 400m**. The Bullpups added several other top finishes across relays, pole vault, high jump, and individual events.



Jr High Golf - Both the boys and girls golf teams moved on from Sectionals and competed at the State Competition. **Our boys team finished as State Champions** and were represented by Grayson Bloemer, James Gilmore, Nash Hoene, Cameron McAllaster, Brooks Niebrugge & Beckett Sams.



Jr High Boys Baseball - The Bullpups Baseball team ended their season with a record of 17-4. **The Bullpups won the first state championship in school history** and tied the state record for most hits in the tournament.
